HISTORY OF WESTONBIRT HOUSE

A Victorian mansion, Westonbirt House was built in the late 1800s by Robert Staynor Holford. One of the wealthiest men in England, he commissioned architect Lewis Vulliamy to design the most expensive and luxurious country house built during that period.

Westonbirt's Elizabethan-style architecture, breathtaking interiors and stunning gardens truly set it apart. A school for almost a century, it is a unique, magical setting in which to live, learn and grow. The Cotswolds is considered one of the most beautiful parts of the UK, with breathtaking countryside and charming, quintessentially

English villages. It is home to several members of the British Royal Family and famous for horse eventing and polo. Within easy distance of Westonbirt are the Cotswold Lakes, the UNESCO World Heritage City of Bath, Roman villas, castles and royal palaces.

A LEADING BRITISH BOARDING SCHOOL

Westonbirt School is a leading co-educational day and boarding school that has a long history of hosting overseas students.

Summer School students arrive to immerse themselves in English language, British culture and an enhanced learning programme, often returning as full-time students following their summer experience.

For almost 100 years we have been welcoming students from across the world to flourish in the beautiful setting of Westonbirt House. Nestled in the heart of the Cotswolds, just 90 minutes from London, the expansive estate is home to a 9-hole golf course, 25m swimming pool, sports fields, theatre, landscaped gardens and our very own chapel.

ACADEMIC OPTIONS

English Language

Our core programme helps students develop their English language proficiency. We offer tuition to all students from beginners who are just starting their language journey to fluent speakers looking to enhance their skills, further expanding their vocabulary and refining their communication style.

AI and Future Technologies

Our AI programmes are designed to improve students' technical knowledge as well as critical-thinking skills, focusing on hands-on learning. Through block coding or Python programming, students will develop essential skills, exploring the fascinating concepts of AI in a supportive environment.

Leadership Programmes

Develop essential leadership skills through immersive activities that take leadership beyond the classroom and into the real world.

Adventure Challenge

Students build teamwork, resilience and confidence through exciting challenges like raft building, orienteering, bushcraft, high ropes, archery and climbing while developing problem-solving skills and environmental awareness.





INTEGRATION PROJECTS

International students share three afternoon sessions a week with UK Host Students, developing a range of skills in an immersive environment.

All students participate in Team Project Challenges, carefully designed to develop and improve English language skills through communication, problem-solving, critical thinking, teamwork, listening, presentation and leadership.

Students work collaboratively with English Host Students to create an innovative project, with the winning team each week receiving a special prize!

TRIPS

There are three excursions each week. Full-day excursions take place on Saturdays, with half-day trips on Wednesdays and Sundays (for those not arriving or leaving that day).

Students up to the age of 12 are always supervised on excursions, while those aged over 12 may be given limited free time to explore the area in small groups, with parental consent.



ACTIVITIES AND ACADEMIES

At Westonbirt, we want students to experience as many different opportunities as possible, to find new passions and discover new aspects of activities they already enjoy.

Our Academy options offer up to eight hours of professional teaching or coaching per week and are a great way to experience the dedicated support that Westonbirt offers to students.

The Multi-Activity Programme is a great choice for students who would like to do a bit of everything, from sport to craft.



EVENINGS

After a busy day of learning and fun, students can enjoy the beautiful grounds or hang out with friends in their boarding house. They are also able to contact family, to tell them about each day's adventures.

The evening continues with social activities, including quizzes, discos, and karaoke or movie nights. As well as lots of fun, this time is a perfect opportunity for students to continue to use their English in an even more relaxed environment.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

COURSE OVERVIEW

All English language lessons are delivered by qualified and experienced teachers. Each member of our teaching team holds a high standard of qualification, such as CELTA, and brings formal classroom experience to the role. The programme is led by our Director of Studies, who holds a DELTA qualification in Applied Linguistics, ensuring high-quality academic delivery and personalised learning support.

Students can benefit from up to 15 hours of language lessons each week.

In addition to English lessons, Integration Projects and academically focused activities enable students to continue language learning beyond the classroom - promoting fluency, confidence, and critical thinking through practical application and collaboration.

Our programme develops:

- Practical language skills in an English-speaking environment
- Listening and reading skills in an exciting way, using as many authentic materials as possible (depending on students' abilities)
- Speaking and writing skills using a topic-based approach, focusing on students' experiences through reflective writing and on oral communication skills through debates and presentations
- Critical thinking skills by helping students reflect on their language use
- Intercultural awareness

A mix of General English and IB English textbooks and authentic materials

Levels:

On arrival, students take a short test to ensure they join the English class that's just right for them. Before they travel, we ask families for an idea of their English level. This way, every student starts in a class that is tailored to their English ability as well as their needs.



FLUENT SPEAKERS

Our approach to teaching is topic-based, inspired by IB English (rather than General English) for higher-level learners, which means that fluent speakers at C1 and C2 levels enjoy a high-level, practical engagement with the English language.

It ensures that students with particularly advanced standards of English skills (for example, those who attend international schools, have studied English skills for a long time or have, in fact, grown up speaking English) are still challenged at the right level in class.

INTEGRATION PROJECTS

On three afternoons each week, students take part in Integration Projects alongside their UK Host Students.

INTEGRATION PROJECTS (ALL AGES)

All students take part in Team Project Challenges, designed to develop communication, problem-solving, critical thinking, listening, presentation, and leadership skills. Students are grouped by age and mixed English ability, and work together with English Host Students to create an innovative project. Each week, the winning team receives a special prize!



Eco Challenge

Students explore the unique environment of Westonbirt, exploring the flora and fauna of the parkland and the lake, and create bug hotels. They also assess the ecological impact of our Summer School and work out what actions could make it more eco-friendly.

Engineering Challenge

Putting their engineering skills to the test, this challenge involves constructing bridges and catapults from a limited bank of resources. Teams compete to see whose catapult can shoot the furthest, and whose bridge withstands the most force.

Entrepreneurial Challenge

In this challenge, inspired by the ever-popular Dragons' Den series, students research, develop and market a brand-new idea, finally pitching their business to potential investors. They explore budgets, market research and profit margins.

Digital Futures Challenge

Students explore how technology is shaping the world. They investigate opportunities and challenges of a connected world and design a digital solution to a real-world problem, such as an app prototype, social media campaign, or tech-based invention.

ACADEMIES AND ACTIVITIES

Westonbirt's outstanding facilities and extensive grounds allow us to offer professional tuition in a wide range of high-quality academy opportunities on four afternoons each week. Students can opt to receive up to eight hours of coaching per week in their chosen academies or they can decide to join the Multi-Activity Programme and spend more time with our UK Host Students doing a variety of activities.



MULTI-ACTIVITY PROGRAMME

Students who do not want to specialise in an academy can take part in this Multi-Activity Programme, where they will have the chance to try different activities every afternoon. Students enjoy up to three activities per day, with a choice of at least one for each session.

Options may include basketball, swimming, football, touch rugby, badminton, kwik cricket, arts and crafts, water polo, softball, rounders and volleyball.

Students will learn a range of classic cooking techniques and create a different dish each day.

FLYING (14+)

Our most adventurous students can experience the thrill of flying in microlight aircraft at Cotswolds Airport with their expert instructors. Sessions will introduce students to the theory and practice of flying, including the effect of controls and basic flight manoeuvres.

Beaufort Polo Club, located right next to Westonbirt, is one of the UK's leading polo venues, offering top-class facilities and a rich heritage in the sport. Established in 1872, the club is renowned for hosting prestigious tournaments, and it's just the perfect place for our advanced riders to play or practice the sport. Only available for experienced riders.

Session length: 4 x 1-hour sessions per week

Equipment: Hats are provided; students must bring riding boots and trousers

HORSE RIDING

The Cotswolds is famous horse-riding country, and home to the internationally renowned Badminton Horse Trials. Students get the chance to develop their riding skills (walking, trotting and cantering) and even develop skills in stable management and grooming.

STAYING WITH US

ACCOMMODATION

Westonbirt House is a beautiful place to live. An English country house full of character, Westonbirt is known for its striking architecture and impressive interiors.

Our bright and cosy single rooms and 2-6 bed dorms provide a comfortable and reassuring space for students to relax and sleep. Rooms are allocated depending on numbers, but in general, older students have priority for the single rooms.

Students are supported and cared for by friendly house parents, who make sure that their stay is safe and fun, arranging medical support if necessary.



FOOD

Food at Westonbirt is delicious! Our on-site school chefs serve a varied and nutritious range of meals, with enough choice to meet a wide range of dietary requirements.

Each day, students will enjoy a healthy breakfast, a mid-morning snack, lunch, afternoon snacks and an evening meal, with some more late-night snacks available in the dorms.

Main meals are eaten in the beautiful and ornate dining rooms at Westonbirt.

For full-day and some half-day excursions, a packed lunch is provided.

SAFEGUARDING AND WELFARE

We are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of students, and we realise that it is often a difficult time for students and parents alike to be far from each other. Our comprehensive Safeguarding & Child Protection Policy and extensive procedures ensure that we keep students safe and families comfortable. The points below are only some highlights from our safeguarding and welfare measures.

TRAINED AND APPROACHABLE STAFF

All our staff members participate in safeguarding training specifically for our summer school. They are supported by a highly trained and experienced safeguarding team. Students are looked after by house parents and dedicated welfare support staff, and they can also always approach any of our friendly staff members if they need help.



ENVIRONMENT

We provide a positive, supportive and nurturing environment, where every student can feel safe. While we have clear expectations for behaviour and conduct, we believe in positive behaviour management, which helps students adapt their behaviour to a school system that may be completely new to them.

SECURE CAMPUS AND ACTIVITIES

Westonbirt School is an exceptionally safe location, a self-contained school campus, where students live in a truly secure environment. We have specific risk assessments in place for every activity and excursion we organise.

SAFER RECRUITMENT PRACTICES

We follow safer recruitment processes to ensure that all staff members that work with us are suitable for working with students; this includes conducting appropriate background checks and following up on references for everyone. We also require external suppliers (eg. transport providers) to do the same.

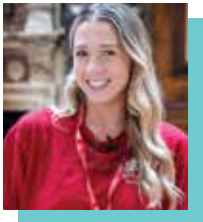


MOBILE PHONE POLICY

While staying with us, students can only use their mobile phones for a limited time in the evenings, while connected to Westonbirt School's safe student network. As well as ensuring that students use their time to communicate with each other, this also helps prevent safeguarding issues linked to the online world. Students do have access to their phones on trips.

DEALING WITH HOMESICKNESS

We know that younger students may find it challenging to adjust to a completely new school environment far from home, and we have great experience in supporting them as well as their families through any periods of homesickness.

TRANSFERS

We provide two levels of transfer services: a Standard Transfer Service and a Premium Transfer Service.

STANDARD TRANSFER SERVICE

London Heathrow and Gatwick Airport

The budget-friendly Standard Transfer Service is available from London Heathrow Airport on Sundays. This includes a meet-and-greet service by a member of school staff or a driver inside the terminal building. On departure, our staff member or driver also takes students to the check-in desk.

The Standard Transfer Service is only available on Sundays for flights:

- Arriving between 9am and 6pm
- Departing between 10am and 7pm

Eurostar shuttles

We are also offering two Standard shuttles on Sundays from/to St Pancras International Station.

The Eurostar Shuttle Transfer Service is available for trains:

- Arriving between 9am and 6pm
- Departing between 10am and 7pm

Waiting times: A staff member or driver will meet students upon arrival.

While we operate multiple transfers throughout the designated times, students may need to wait up to two hours with a staff member before departing, depending on arrival times.

PREMIUM TRANSFER SERVICE

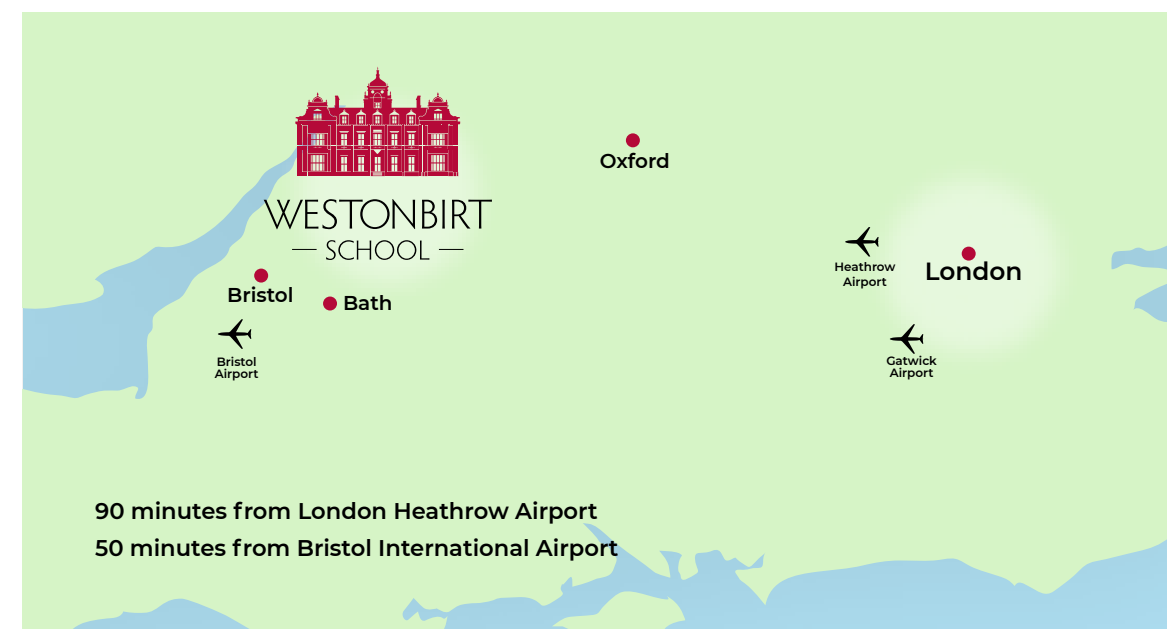
Our Premium Transfer Service is available from all London airports, as well as Bristol Airport and London St Pancras International Station. This option also includes a meet-and-greet service by a member of school staff or a driver inside the terminal building. On departure, our staff member or driver also takes students to the check-in desk.

Students travelling together can share the same Premium Transfer Service.

Waiting times: We plan for our staff member or driver to meet arriving students approximately 45 minutes after their flight arrives (or later if there are delays through arrivals). Premium Transfers leave the airport or station immediately after collecting the student.

UNACCOMPANIED MINORS

We are happy to assist with the arrival and departure of unaccompanied students. It is the responsibility of the family to ensure that this service is available and booked with the airline, and that all necessary paperwork is handed over to us.
